FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- *How can I make my deposit?*

You will submit payments directly to Family Memories Travel. Please see the link on the TCHS Choir website.

- *What should I do if I have a financial question about the trip?*

All financial questions should be directed to Family Memories Travel.

- *Can the sibling of a band or choir student go on the trip?*

Yes, provided that the sibling is traveling with the guardian of a band or choir student and is not a student at TCHS. The price for siblings will be the same as the price for chaperones and students.

- *As a parent/guardian, can I go on the trip and NOT ride the bus/chaperone students?*

No. You may make your own travel arrangements and purchase your own tickets to Disney World but we will not consider you as a trip participant. Additionally, we cannot allow you to assume responsibility for students who are considered trip participants.

- *What should I do if my child has a medical condition or needs a nurse while on the trip?*

We highly encourage parents in this situation to attend as a chaperone. However, if you are unable to attend, we will have a school nurse in attendance.

- *Can my child and I room together on the trip?*

Yes, we will give all trip participants the opportunity to make room requests.

- *My child is in both band and choir. Which workshop will he/she participate in?*

The directors will collaborate and help your child determine in which workshop he/she will participate.

- *How do I make sure my choir student is eligible to participate in the trip?*

DISNEY'S CANDLELIGHT PROCESSIONAL - TCHS CHOIR ELIGIBILITY

What is Disney's Candlelight Processional?

- Disney's Candlelight Processional is a full-scale Disney production that takes place every year at Epcot between Thanksgiving and Christmas. Celebrity narrators and Disney performers tell the Christmas story through song and Bible narration.
- High school choirs from around the country apply to be a part of this performance. Not every choir is selected.
- Students who plan to travel with TCHS Choir should understand that your participation in the Candlelight Processional is an honor.
- Students who plan to travel with TCHS Choir will be responsible for learning the music for the Candlelight Processional performance. Some class time will be spent on the music, but students may also have to spend time outside of class preparing.
- Students who plan to travel with TCHS Choir will be expected to prove mastery of the music. Students may be asked to pass-off the music in a large group, small group, individually, or by video submission.
- In short, we intend to arrive at Disneyworld prepared for the performance, and we will hold you to that standard.

Who is eligible to participate?

- Any student who is a member of the 2024-2025 TCHS Mixed Choir has already passed off *Do You Hear What I Hear*, is already eligible to travel with TCHS Choir, and does not need to do anything else to be eligible to travel.
- Other current and future students of TCHS Choir are eligible to travel, but must complete a short vocal pass-off of *Do You Hear What I Hear*.

Pass-Off Instructions

- Use the attached sheet music to learn your voice part of measures 34-55 of *Do You Hear What I Hear*. Rehearsal tracks are available by visiting the TCHS Choir website – tchschoral.com - and clicking on "Rehearsal Tracks." If you do not know which voice part to choose, try a few and choose the one that works best with your voice.
- Use the "Piano Only" track to make a recording of yourself singing measures 34-55 of *Do You Hear What I Hear*.
- Submit the completed recording by scanning this QR code and uploading your video.
