- During the processional of the graduates, you will come to your place in the choir setup. Make sure that you tell the people who are behind you in line to LEAVE YOUR SEAT OPEN and make sure that they know NOT TO FOLLOW YOU to the choir setup. ©
- PRO TIP Pin in your stole (the white thing) to your gown so that it doesn't fly off when you are walking.
- You will stay in your place in the choir setup during Mr. Williams welcome.
 Please remain standing and quiet during this time.
- After you sing "Landslide" you will go to your seats.
- At the end of the program, Charles
 Parker and the band will lead the Alma
 Mater. Please sing out from your place
 among the graduates and help lead the
 whole group.
