WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

10th, 11th, or 12th grade students with parent and high school counselor approval.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Academic dual courses: minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or 80 on a 100 point scale
- Technical dual courses: minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or 75 on a 100 point scale
- Admission to Shelton State Community College
- Statement of eligibility with required signature(s)
