To remain an active member of the National Honor Society, eight (8) hours of your service hours must come from NHS service projects and after-school tutoring. The other four (4) hours need to come from volunteerism in the community or through other service projects. These service hours are limited to school or community volunteer work for which no compensation is received—monetary payment, a grade, or credit hours for another organization.
