

Brookwood Elementary School BYOD for Kids



The following is a list of procedures that will allow children to bring their own mobile devices to school to be used for school work. This is a privilege, not a right, and failure to follow any of these procedures will result in disciplinary action.

- 1. You will never be required to bring your device to school. There is plenty of available technology at BWES including computer labs, iPads and NEO 2's
- 2. You are responsible for keeping your device safe. No one at the school or county board is responsible for a lost, stolen, or damaged device. It is your responsibility.
- 3. Use skins, decals, or labels to make it easy to know which device is yours.
- 4. You must use the school's Wi-Fi. You may NOT use 3G or 4G at school. We will teach you how to access our Wi-Fi.







- 7. Your device may not be used to cheat on assignments or tests.
- 8. You may not use your device to make phone calls, instant message or text, at any time during school hours, 7:30-3:15.
- 9. You may not take pictures or videos with your device.





- 10. You may not play any games on your device unless they are part of your teacher's assignment.
- 11. You may not print from your device at school.



- 12. You may not connect your device to any network cable outlet or computer in the school.
- 13. Charge your device before you bring it to school. You may not charge your device at school.
- 14. You must follow any other rules or procedures your teacher may set up for your classroom.
- 15. You may not use your device on the school bus.
