NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY BY-LAWS

Brookwood Middle School

ARTICLE I

Name and Purpose

<u>Section 1-</u> The name of this organization shall be the Brookwood Middle School chapter of the National Junior Honor Society.

<u>Section 2-</u> The purpose of this organization shall be to create enthusiasm for scholarship, to stimulate a desire to render service, to promote leadership, to develop character, and to encourage citizenship in the students of Brookwood Middle School.

ARTICLE II

Selection Procedures

<u>Section 1-</u> The sponsors develop and revise, when necessary, all chapter procedures for selection, disciplining, and dismissal of members. Selection is conducted by a committee made up of 5 teachers from Brookwood Middle School. This committee is selected by the principal of Brookwood Middle School.

Section 2- To be eligible for consideration for membership, the candidate must have attended Brookwood Middle School the equivalent of one full semester, must have a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.5 out of a 4.0 on a 4.0 scale in regular or advanced core classes. A student would also be eligible if the student is a NJHS member who transfers from another school and brings a letter from the principal or chapter adviser to the Brookwood Middle School adviser. Upon receipt of the letter by the Brookwood Middle School Adviser, the transfer student shall be accepted automatically as a member in Brookwood Middle School's chapter. Transfer members must meet the new chapter's standards within one semester in order to retain membership.

<u>Section 3-</u> Students will not be considered for membership if they have received any office referrals for the current year. Students who have been assigned to ASD or OSS for the current year will not be considered for membership in the NJHS.
