

NORTHSIDE SENIORS-ONLY PAINTED PARKING SPOTS

SENIORS! You have the chance to paint your very own PARKING SPOT for the 2022-2023 school year! By filling out this form, you are eligible for one reserved spot that will be your reserved space for the year!

If you are a senior for the 2022-2023 school year and wish to participate, you must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Complete a 2022-2023 Senior Parking Spot Agreement (below) and turn it in by Wednesday, July 27 at noon
- Pay a fee of \$50.00 to Northside High School by Wednesday, July 27, at noon (turn in with agreement)
- Submit a parking spot design for administrative approval by Wednesday, July 27, **at noon**. (see below)

Seniors can paint their parking spot **on the dates below** (They can paint them after these dates as well, but not before these dates.):

Painting Dates and Times:

August 8 8 am - 12 pm

August 9 8 am - 12 pm

Names will be randomly drawn at 3:00 pm on Friday, August 5, and will be broadcast live on the school's Instagram account (@rams_hs). The results will be posted in the order drawn on the school's social media platforms upon completion. Students will have until Monday, August 8, at 8:00 am, to email Mr. Ray (JLRAY@tcss.net) and choose their spot. After this time, Mr. Ray will assign spots to students. Students who purchase after the draw will select their parking spot on a first come, first served-basis.

In order to follow all county and district codes, please read and sign the guidelines below for the painted parking spots stating that you will oblige and that you understand that if the guidelines aren't followed your privileges will be revoked.

STUDENT PARKING SPACE RULES

1. You **MUST** purchase your own paint and brushes to use to decorate your parking spot. **WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT** is the only type of paint that can be used.
2. Student **MUST** clean spills and discard all unused materials. **NO PAINT MAY BE DISPOSED OF ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. STUDENTS ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR PAINT DISPOSAL OFF CAMPUS.**
3. **HAVE FUN!!!** The purpose of allowing students to paint their own parking spot is aimed at improving school pride and camaraderie. Students can "own" a piece of the school. We encourage students to express themselves through **POSITIVE** artwork.
4. Paint your name (at least your first name) somewhere in your spot. Please do not use nicknames.
5. **All designs must be pre-approved by the administration.** Students may email design requests to Mr. Ray (JLRAY@tcss.net). They are due no later than Wednesday, July 27, 2021. Remember, purchasing a student parking spot is completely optional and this reservation does not guarantee you one of the spots. There will be parking spaces available for students who do not wish to purchase and/or decorate a space. However, students who purchase the right to paint their parking spot will receive priority parking (i.e. you will be able to choose your spot, given it is available when your name is drawn in the lottery). Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration. Disciplinary and Criminal actions may be taken. If this happens, you will not only be forfeiting your right to a parking space and/or to drive on campus, but you will also forfeit any monies collected.
6. Students **MAY NOT** deface or park in anyone else's reserved space. Appropriate disciplinary action will be taken if this happens.
7. A **\$200 fee** will be added to your account if your parking spot is not painted over with **BLACK WATER-BASED LATEX** paint by 10 calendar days prior to the announced date of graduation.

Seniors who have completed the following may participate in the live drawing for parking spaces on August 5:

- ___ Submit a sketch of proposed parking space design by Wednesday, July 27, 2022, at noon.
- ___ Submit this Parking Spot Agreement form by Wednesday, July 27, 2022 at noon
- ___ Payment (cash, check made to NHS, or receipt of payment through myschoolfees.com)

Students are reminded that the Northside High School Code of Conduct and all local laws will be enforced regarding the Senior Parking Space Personalization process. Wording or marks of drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs, or sexual connotation will lead to punishment and/or criminal action (**this includes rebel flags**). At any time during the year, Northside High School reserves the right to deny or remove the Senior Parking Space Painting privilege if any of the above occurs. All paint, supplies and clean-up are the responsibility of the student.
