#### **AP Exams**

If your student is enrolled in an AP course, they will be required to take the College Board's AP Exam in May. There is an additional cost for these exams. A letter was given to your students this week explaining the costs and including the dates of each exam. Some students have several exams to pay for so I will gladly start collecting payments now. Hopefully, this will help you to be able to spread the fees out over this semester. All exams must be paid for by Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup>.

All seniors took the Work Keys Test on October 2<sup>nd</sup> at Brookwood High School. This test is given by many industries to measure foundational skills required for success in the workplace, and help measure the workplace skills that can affect job performance. Individuals who successfully complete the three WorkKeys Assessments—Applied Math, Graphic Literacy, and Workplace Documents—earn the WorkKeys National Career Readiness Certificate, a valuable credential for students and job seekers seeking to verify foundational workplace skills. Students should receive their score reports next week in their Advisory class. If your student did not earn a Silver (level 4) on the test, they will be required to retake the sections where they scored below level 4 in March. If your student did earn a minimum of a Silver on the test, they will receive a "free day" out of school as a reward for their high score. This day may be used at their discretion.

#### **Financial Aid**

The FAFSA, which is the free online financial aid application, opened in October. Remember, it is a requirement that all students complete the FAFSA this year for graduation. There are many programs and scholarships that require a student to complete the FAFSA in order to qualify for the money being given. This application can be found at <a href="https://www.fafsa.ed.gov">www.fafsa.ed.gov</a> and you will need to use your 2020 income tax returns to complete this application. Please feel free to call me or have your student schedule an appointment with me so we can complete this together.

#### **Beyond Brookwood Week:**

I am excited that we will be having our 8<sup>th</sup> annual Beyond Brookwood Week February 14th-18th. This week we spend time making sure our seniors are ready to enter the workforce. Students will work to develop soft skills needed in the workplace. The week will conclude with a Mock Interview on Thursday, February 18th. Students will be expected to dress appropriately for the interview and bring their resume. Interview attire may be the same as the graduation attire, but it does not have to be the same. Please start talking with your student now about this event and the importance of being career ready.

#### Reminders:

Students do not have to know which college they plan on attending at this point in the year. It is best to apply to multiple colleges and complete all scholarships prior to deadlines. Once awards are made in the spring, students can weigh their options and see which college they want to commit to. They will not be able to go back and apply for scholarships once the deadline has passed.

Students should be checking their personal and college emails **DAILY**. Most colleges use an online system to convey information to future and current students. It is very important that students look at this everyday so that they don't miss any deadlines.

#### Steps to complete:

- ✓ Apply to colleges
- ✓ Submit any necessary documents (transcripts, ACT scores, etc.)
- ✓ Learn how to navigate their online student portals (this is where your student email account is, where you register for classes, complete scholarship applications, etc)
- ✓ Complete all scholarship applications by deadlines
- ✓ Check emails daily

#### **Need My Transcript**

All seniors must make any transcript requests by going to www.needmytranscript.com in order to send their transcripts. This is the program we will use to send final transcripts after graduation.
