#### Graduation Dress Code

All seniors participating in the Graduation Ceremony are required to follow the dress code below. Please let Mrs. Barnett know if you have any trouble securing these items.

- ❖ Females: Dress (no longer than the length of the Graduation Gown), Black Dress Shoes
- ❖ Males: White Button-up Shirt, Dark Colored Tie, Black Dress Pants, Black Belt, Black Dress Shoes

- ✓ Balfour will return to the BHS campus on November 10<sup>th</sup> (at lunch) to take senior orders. Please have your student bring their order form (completed) and their money.
- ✓ You can order online if you choose to do that by going to [MRMgradsales.com](http://MRMgradsales.com) to place your order.
- ✓ If you have any questions you can call me at school or contact Balfour directly at (866) 402-7464.
- ✓ The only thing that is required to order is the Graduation Supply Fee (#24 on the order form) which includes the student's cap, gown, stole, diploma, diploma cover. This fee is \$90 + 10% sales tax + \$15 shipping = \$114. The other items are optional.
- ✓ You can purchase any of the other items individually or purchase one of the packages if that is what you choose; however, the packages do not include the Graduation Supply Fee.
- ✓ Please be sure to order these items by the deadline so they arrive in time for graduation.

### **Visit a College**

Don't forget you have 3 days this school year to visit a college of your choice and the absence be counted as a school activity. The forms for documentation are available in the Counseling Office or you may print them off from the BHS website. Sometimes visiting a college is all you need to make your final decision about whether that school is right for you. Please take advantage of this opportunity. Many colleges are still scheduling private tours so contact the College Admissions Representatives to set this up.

### **College Application Week**

College Application Week was a huge success! Our seniors submitted 468 college applications during this week. They all worked very hard as we spent the week hearing from multiple colleges, submitting applications, completing scholarships, and working on the FAFSA. There is still time to get these things done so students should continue to work on these items. I am still available to help with any of these processes.

**Financial Aid Updates:**

This year, all seniors must complete the FAFSA as a graduation requirement. If your senior is planning to attend college then this is one of the steps in this process. If your senior is not planning to attend college then I can complete a waiver to exempt them from this requirement. Please have them stop by my office to let me know their intentions.

The FAFSA is not hard to complete; however, you must be sure to enter your information accurately so it is processed quickly and without any extra documentation being required. It is very important to complete this as soon as possible to secure the most money for your student. EVERY STUDENT who plans on attending college should complete the FAFSA regardless of your income bracket. Many colleges require the FAFSA be completed to receive scholarships. You are not obligated to take any of the funding offered to you, just simply complete the process. You will use your 2020 income tax returns to complete the FAFSA. ### **Hagan Scholarship Foundation**

Amount: Up to \$48,000

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

1. Must be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Must attend an Eligible Public High School.
3. Must have achieved a 3.75 Cumulative Grade Point Average.
4. Must enroll at an Eligible Four-Year College or University the first semester following high school graduation.
5. Must work 240 hours prior to fall semester college enrollment. Applicants have from August 2021 to August 2022 to fulfill this requirement. Preferred employment is regularly scheduled non-family employment performed under supervision for compensation. However, if you work on a family farm or for a family business this may be acceptable for first year recipients.
6. Must provide the FAFSA SAR showing the EFC. Must be Pell Grant eligible. The family EFC does not have to be paid, it is used only to determine award amounts.
7. Must not have a felony conviction.

Application open October 1st. Graduating Alabama seniors, including home schooled students, are encouraged to apply for the Smith Scholarship early. Deadline for completed applications will be January 12, 2022. Each application requires personal background information, transcripts, description of school and community involvement. Three 300-500-word essays and a 500-word minimum personal statement. Letters of recommendation answering specific questions about the applicant are required. Students may also add optional submissions of written works, art, and upload vocal, music or dramatic pieces if they desire at their sole discretion. Such additional submissions are completely voluntary. While a C+ GPA is required, no specific ACT/SAT score is included. Students must complete either the ACT or SAT and the FASFA application.

To be considered for academic, leadership, or alumni scholarship assistance a student must meet unconditional Admissions standards (19 or higher ACT or 990 or higher SAT and 2.0 or better GPA) and apply for admission to UWA and scholarships by April 15.
