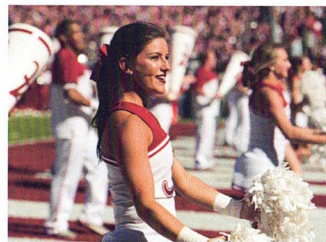

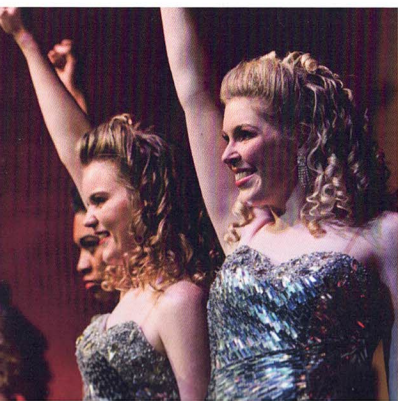
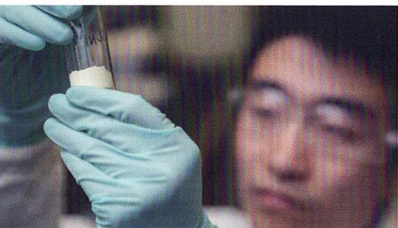
If none of these majors or programs is quite right, New College allows ambitious students to design their own major, drawing from programs throughout the University.

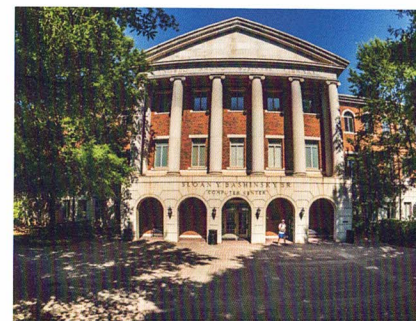

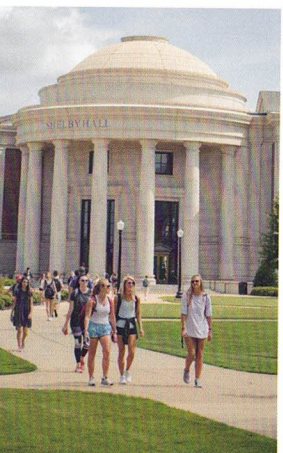

COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING

- 19 students have been named Goldwater Scholars, the most prestigious undergraduate scholarship in natural sciences, engineering and mathematics.
- With a new state-of-the-art lab, Alabama Astrobotics has won the NASA Robotic Mining Competition each of the past five years.
- Three students have been named to Aviation Week's 20 Twenties list, sponsored by the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, recognizing the nation's top STEM students.
- UA's EcoCAR 3 team finished No. 3 overall at the final competition for designing and constructing an energy-efficient vehicle in 2018.
- UA's Formula SAE team, Crimson Racing, placed No. 10 out of 108 international teams from eight countries at the Formula SAE Michigan competition in 2019 and No. 1 in the SEC.

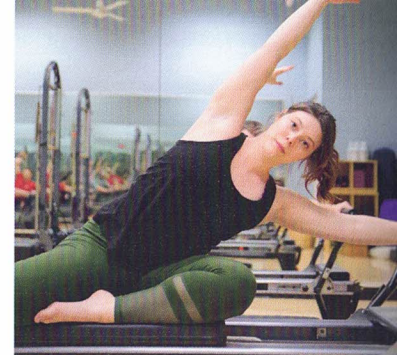

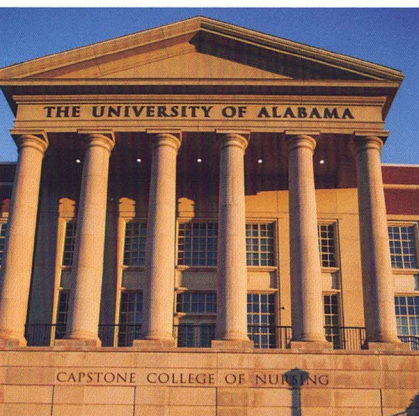


COLLEGE OF HUMAN ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES

- In Fashion for Life, senior apparel design students from the department of clothing, textiles and interior design host a fashion show each fall, showcasing student work and raising funds for charity.
- Students who complete the coordinated program in dietetics through the human nutrition and hospitality management department have a 95% first-year pass-rate for the exam to become registered dietitians.
- Two concentrations within human development and family studies provide vital services to the community. Child life specialists help children and families cope in hospital settings. Addiction and recovery graduates are equipped to help combat the opioid crisis.
- Family financial planning and counseling graduates (part of consumer sciences) are well-prepared to sit for the Certified Financial Planner (CFP®) exam and the Accredited Financial Counselor (AFC®) exam, the industry standards for wealth management and financial counseling professionals.

COLLEGE OF NURSING

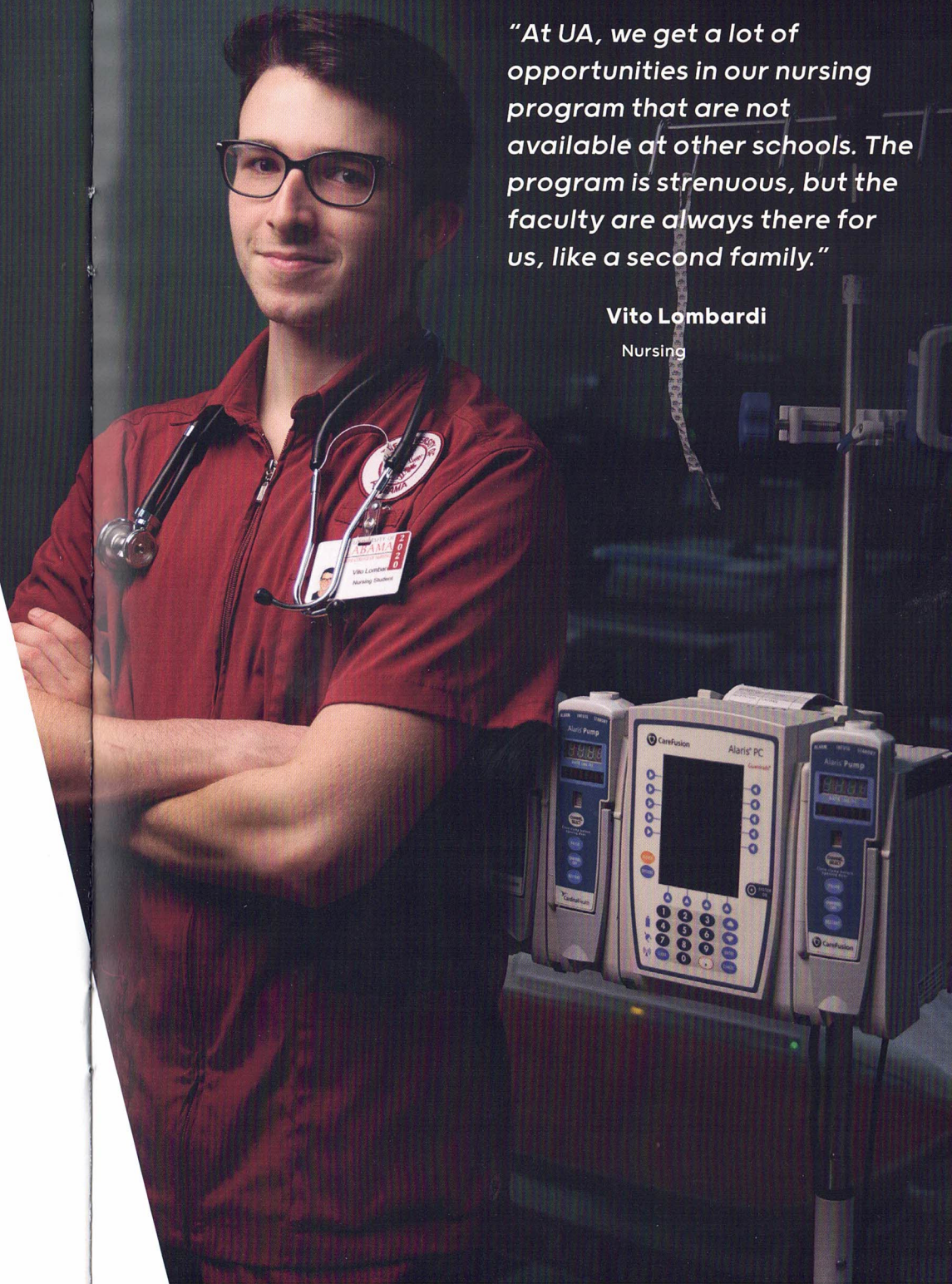
- Recognized as a National League for Nursing Center of Excellence.

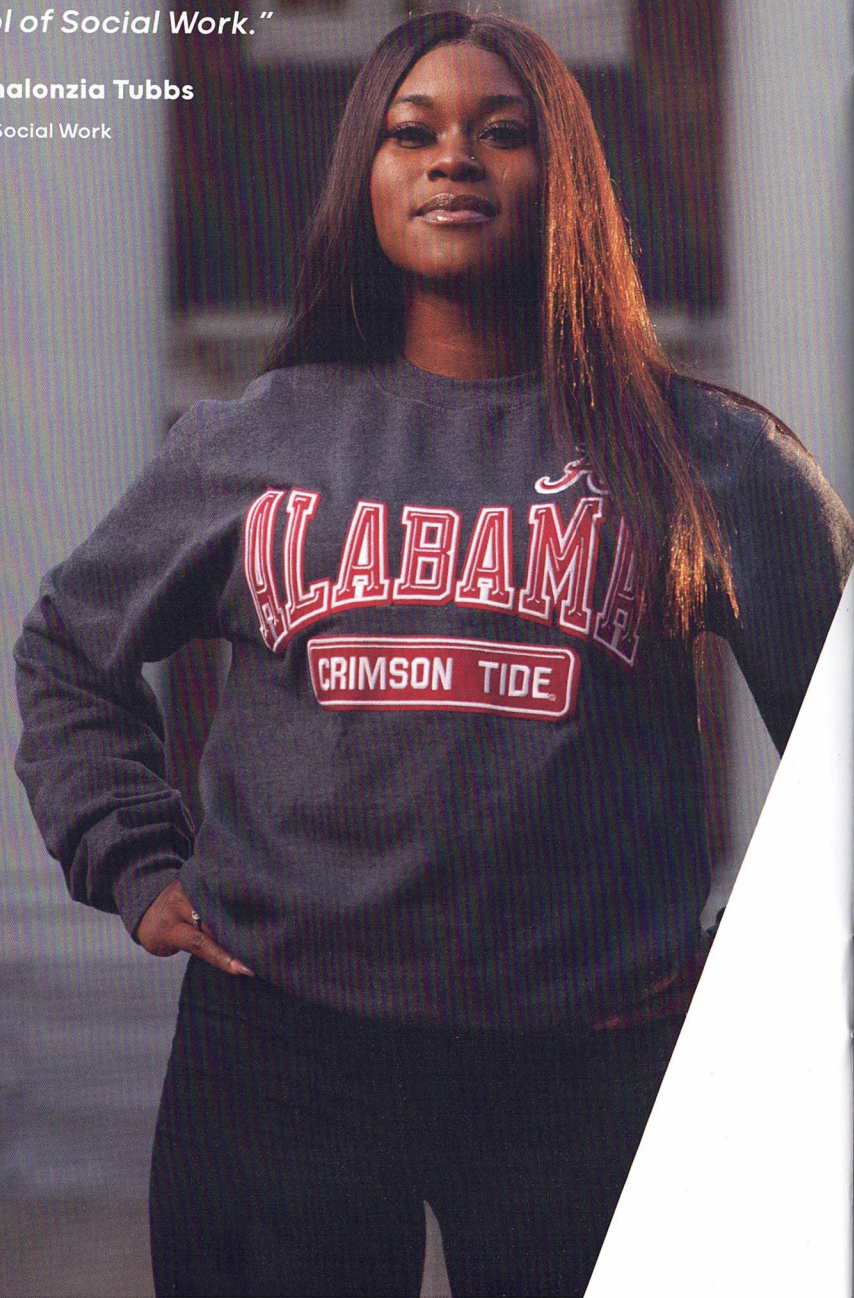

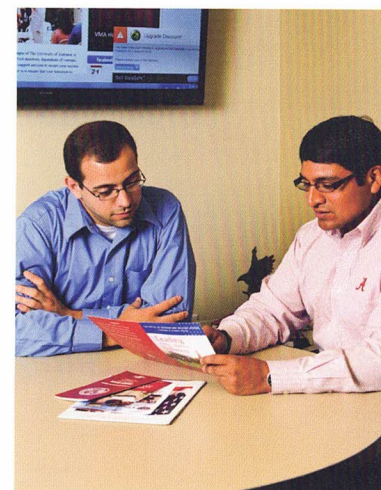
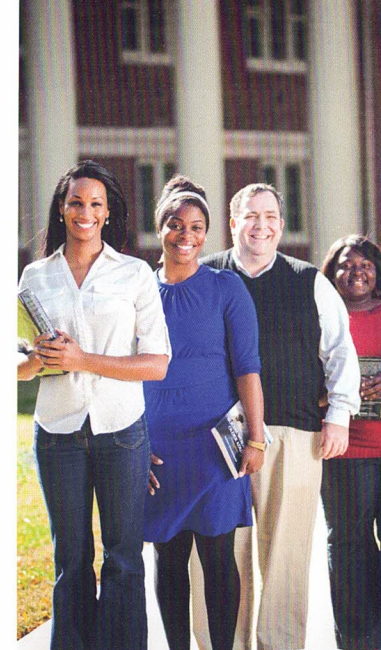
