

TUSCALOOSA COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM DUAL ENROLLMENT/DUAL CREDIT AGREEMENT

The Tuscaloosa County School System is honored to partner with multiple colleges and universities to offer Dual Enrollment and Dual Credit (DE/DC) opportunities for its students. Students who meet eligibility requirements must declare their courses as dual enrollment or dual credit <u>before</u> courses begin each semester. Their definitions are as follows:

DUAL ENROLLMENT (DE) is available to students who would like to earn college credit. DE students may take college courses and will receive college credit ONLY for all coursework. DE students' courses and grades **will not** be reflected on the high school transcript but **will be** reflected on the college transcript alone. No weighted credit is awarded for DE courses.

<u>DUAL ENROLLMENT/DUAL CREDIT (DE/DC)</u> is available to students who would like to earn both high school and college credits for the equivalent course(s). DE/DC courses <u>will</u> be posted to the college transcript, <u>will</u> be added to the high school transcript and <u>will</u> be calculated into the overall grade point average (GPA). Weighted credit <u>may</u> be awarded as appropriate.
