From time to time, your child's teacher (or the student themselves) may wish to take photos or videos that display laboratory investigations or other class projects. These photos may be available for students to use as they complete on-going, collaborative or end of the year projects such as, but not limited to, Glogster.edu, or Voicethread. Photos or videos will not be displayed online except in a secure manner for students only to access.
