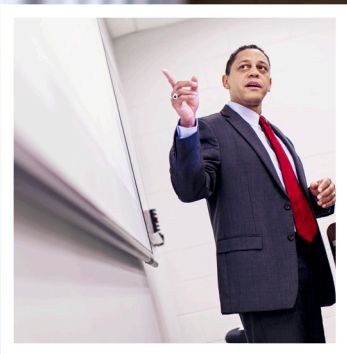

COST AND TUITION

The University of West Alabama is a comprehensive, state-assisted university with a relaxed and comfortable atmosphere.

The cost for tuition, fees, meals, and a space in a residence hall for one academic year is as follows:

SCHOLARSHIPS & AID

Trustee Academic Awards are available to entering freshmen with either a 21 or higher composite ACT score and a 3.0 or better GPA. Students may also qualify for an academic award without ACT/SAT scores if they have a 3.0 or better GPA. **Scholarships are renewable for up to four academic years** with a minimum 3.0 GPA. On campus residency required.

Other Scholarships include Valedictorian & Salutatorian awards, Leadership awards, as well as a host of other academic, service, and achievement scholarships. Leadership awards are available to entering freshman that participated in various leadership activities in high school. **All UWA scholarships are stackable.** On campus residency required and applicants must submit an online scholarship application.
